Immediate Source of Acquisition: Received as a gift from Gerald S. Bush in 1996.

Processing Information: This collection was received as a gift from Gerald S. Bush in June 1995 and accessioned by Meg Klinkow in October 1996. The architectural drawings (1996.06.01-.13) and the certificate survey (1996.06.14) were originally described separately. The collection was later reviewed and intellectually reunited under a single collection-level record as the Lewis Lozier Collection (Arch2006.10). All architectural drawings were rehoused together in flat file storage at the Archive Learning Resource Center. Ther certificate of survey is housed in its own folder within an archival box and also located at the Archive Learning Resource Center.

The collection was reprocessed by Andria Castillo in February 2026 to update arrangement and description and to ensure all related materials were represented within a unified finding aid.

Biographical or Administrative History

The materials in this collection were donated as a gift by Gerald S. Bush and received by the repository on June 29, 1995, by Meg Klinkow. This collection documents the Lewis H. Lozier House at 7218 Quick Ave., River Forest, Illinois and includes blueprints and a 1938 certificate of survey for Cicero State Bank by the National Survey Service of Chicago, Il. Dr. M.J. Summerville was a gynecologist, part of the consulting staff at Manteno Ill, State Hospital 1939-1940.

Scope and Content

The Lewis Lozier House Collection contains architectural drawings (13 blueprint sheets) for the Lewis H. Lozier House, designed by Tallmadge and Watson, including elevations, floor plans and building details. The collection also includes a 1938 certificate of survey prepared by Cicero State Bank by the National Survey Service of Chicago, Illinois, created for the purpose of a mortgage loan applied for on May 18, 1938, by Dr. M.J. and Normal J. Summerville.
